Led by qualified health professionals and tailored to the needs of people with arthritis, our Warm Water Classes are currently run across metropolitan Sydney, with plans to expand the program throughout regional NSW.

Webinars

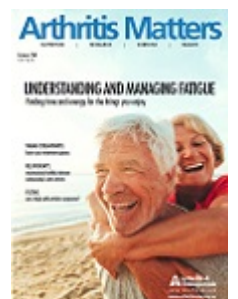
Designed to deliver education that is accessible from home or office, our webinar series covers topics such as diet, exercise, pain management and much more.
